Yet again we exceeded all
expectations to achieve another
fantastic year with our Sats
results.

For Year 6
93% achieved the expected standard in English grammar, punctuation and spalling with

standard in English grammar, punctuation and spelling with 64% achieving the greatest depth. 86% achieved the expected standard in reading with 54% achieving the greater depth, and 93% achieving the expected standard in writing and maths. (57% greater depth) these are truly a remarkable set of results of which we are extremely proud. Well done to all our Year 6 pupils for all their hard work and to Mr Secker and Mr Kelly for making it happen!

Thank you especially to Mrs Jeni Robinson for all her hard work and organisation.




PTFA dates for your diary...



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
