Results Are Out

Another successful year!
Yet again we exceeded all expectations to achieve another fantastic year with our Sats results.

For Year 6

93% achieved the expected standard in English grammar, punctuation and spelling with 64% achieving the greatest depth. 86% achieved the expected standard in reading with 54% achieving the greater depth, and 93% achieving the expected standard in writing and maths. (57% greater depth) these are truly a remarkable set of results of which we are extremely proud. Well done to all our Year 6 pupils for all their hard work and to Mr Secker and Mr Kelly for making it happen!






Year 3 PAFC award for Macy


