
What is PiYo?

STEM

Year 5 and 6 attended a STEM event at UTC Plymouth on Thursday. We were able to explore technology, which included using infrared thermometers, on the Titan truck and build bridges using a variety of materials. These bridges had to be able to take the weight of a radio-controlled car. In one of the science laboratories we were able to use Bunsen burners to ignite different solutions containing metal.
