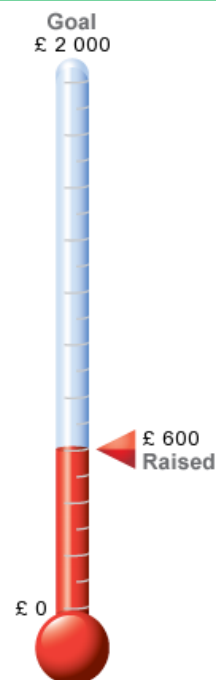
PTFA Update
